Provided with SketchUp Pro, the LayOut tool is used to produce plans and documentation.

SketchUp LayOut training teaches everything you need to produce large and small documents for professional purposes such as Planning and Building regulations, contract and construction drawings.



Course summary

Teaches how to produce professional-standard produce plans and documentation from your Sketchup models, drawings and specifications. Sessions include:

- Importing your Sketchup drawings, plans and renders.
- Creating plans and documents from your 3D models.
- Constructing your own title blocks and page layouts.
- Adding annotations, specifications and dimensions.
- Printing to scale and exporting for digital distribution and printing.

This course is aimed at new and existing users of SketchUp Pro, running on a Windows or Mac computer.

Delegates should have good computing skills. No prior CAD knowledge is necessary.

Pre-requisites?

You should have good working knowledge of SketchUp for 3D modelling, i.e. be familiar with the techniques taught in our *Introduction to SketchUp* course (see armada.co.uk/sketchup/syllabus).
